ARTIST BIOGRAPHY


Mongezi Ncaphayi was born in 1983 in Gauteng, South Africa, where he currently lives and works. Ncaphayi graduated with a Diploma in Art & Design from the Ekurhuleni East College-Benoni in 2005, a Professional Printmaking Course at Artist Proof Studio in 2008 and a Certificate in Advanced Studies from School of the Museum of fine Arts in Boston, USA in 2012. In 2016, he was awarded the Prince Claus Fund Grant in Amsterdam, Netherlands; in 2013, Ncaphayi was the recipient of the Absa L'atelier Gerard Sekoto Award; and in 2011, Ncaphayi received the Ampersand Foundation Fellowship in New York City, USA. Artist-inresidency programmes include: The Atelier le Grand Village Residency in Angouleme, France, in 2014; as well as the Thami Manyele Foundation Residency in Amsterdam, Netherlands, in 2016.

In 2016, Ncaphayi presented his inaugural solo exhibition, *Spirit's Response* at the ABSA Art Gallery in Johannesburg, South Africa. Ncaphayi has since presented two solo exhibitions with SMAC Gallery: *Journey to the One* in 2016 at SMAC Gallery in Johannesburg; and *Which Way is East?* in 2017, at SMAC Gallery in Cape Town, South Africa.








Mongezi Ncaphayi Blue in Green 2018 Indian Ink, Watercolour and Acrylic on Cotton Paper 140 x 100 cm
